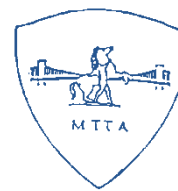

This bulletin is a shortened version of the usual Newsletter to provide information about the forthcoming Marly-le-Roi visit, which is taking place from Wednesday 1st May until Sunday 5th May.

There are fewer friends coming over from Marly this year (approx. 40) and the majority of them have already arranged with their Marlow contacts where they will be staying. This is why we didn't send out the usual form beforehand, asking Members to let us know if they would like to receive any guests, to stay with them in their homes for the four nights. The planned itinerary is detailed below:

Date	Time	Activity	Extra
Wed 1 st May		The coach is expected to arrive sometime in the afternoon. It will park in the Court Garden car park{CG}. Our visitors would then like to stroll around the town.	
	6.0pm	A reception will be held in The Rowing Club to formally welcome our guests. Drinks and canapés will be provided. Following this hosts will take their guests home for dinner – (don't forget that they have had a long day and will have an early start tomorrow)	All MMTTA members are welcome to attend the reception.

Thurs 2 nd May	09.00	Bring your guest/s to Court Garden car park. The coach will depart very shortly afterwards to Lacock Abbey and Fox Talbot Museum (National Trust).	There <u>may</u> be a few places on the coach for hosts to come along as well. If you are interested please contact Wilma. Lunch will be at The Red Lion pub. Hosts will need to pay their own costs, i.e. NT group entrance fee £13.50 if not already an NT member, plus lunch.
Thurs pm	approx. 6.0pm	Hosts to collect their guests from the car park (CG). The coach will leave Lacock at 4.0pm	
Thurs eve	t.b.d.	It is planned to meet up at a local pub for a meal and social get-together for those who wish to.	Hosts will also be expected to pay for their guests.
Fri 3 rd May	10.30am	The coach will depart for Covent Garden in London. The guests will spend the day in London doing their own thing, getting their own lunch until 3.0pm when they will re-board the coach to take them to the Houses of Parliament. At 4pm there will be a guided tour around the Houses of Parliament. This will be done in three groups of 20.	There may be room on the coach for some hosts to come along as well. Up to 60 people can be shown around the Houses of Parliament. At the moment we know of 39 guests attending. Any host who may like to join the party please contact Wilma. First come, first served – seats are free. Unfortunately there is no guarantee of a place on the coach so you may have to make your own way there.

Sat eve	18:30	There will a soirée at Great Marlow School. The theme will be ‘The Regatta’ and hopefully people will dress-up accordingly. Carole Thurston will be providing the buffet and we (the MMTTA) will provide all the drinks (wine, soft drinks, etc.). InterKooler will be providing the music for entertainment and dancing.	This event is free for all hosts and guests. There will be places available for non-hosting members at a cost of £20 per person. A form is below, for anyone not acting as hosts who would like to attend the Soirée. We shall be setting up/decorating the school hall from 4pm onwards, so any help will be welcome.
